Wheat Belt Public Power District will participate in the Tri-State Generation and Transmission Association, Inc. Energy Efficiency Credit Rebate Program. Credits are available to all end-use customer classes. The credit applies to products and services that are purchased or leased by the customer (end-use consumer).

Efficiency standard and rebate minimums are set forth by Tri-State G & T. Any additional rebates offered by Wheat Belt PPD are over and above the Tri-State G & T minimum, are offered upon Wheat Belt PPD Board approval, and subject to review.

All rebates which are less than \$600 will be credited to the customer's Wheat Belt account associated with the rebate. If a customer's rebate totals \$600 or more, a check will be mailed to the customer. Should a customer, qualifying for a rebate, be delinquent in payment of an associated account with Wheat Belt PPD, the Wheat Belt PPD portion of the rebate may be credited against the delinquent account/s.
