Wheat Belt Public Power District, in an effort to increase the efficiency of disconnecting and reconnecting of irrigation wells, offers a rebate to customers on the "I-" rate schedules for the installation of fused or non-fused disconnects. The disconnect shall be placed at the metering point, the customer shall assume ownership of the disconnect and wiring/electrical equipment from that point.

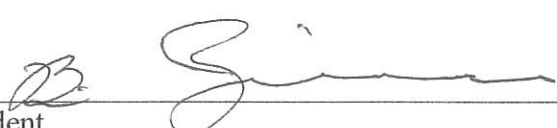
The following rebate will apply:

- Up to \$1,200.00 rebate for service disconnect installations.
- The customer is responsible for working with Wheat Belt for any service specific specifications.
- The installation of the disconnect is the responsibility of the customer and is subject to State and Wheat Belt inspections.
- A receipt with proof of disconnect and installation date must be submitted prior to inspection.
- Rebates will be issued within 30 days of Wheat Belt inspection along with a notification of transfer of ownership.

The District will work with the customer to coordinate disconnecting and reconnecting power for the installation of the disconnect.

Irrigation services with a disconnect already at the metering point are not eligible for this rebate program.

This policy was revised in August of 2023, new inquiries as of September 1, 2023, will be subject to the policy as written. Inquiries prior to September 1, 2023, will be subject to the previous policy version.
